# GYBER BULLYING

Cyber bullying is increasingly common both inside and outside school. Cyber bullying is any form of bullying that involves the use of mobile phones or the internet. For example, sending offensive text messages and emails, circulating degrading images on the internet, or pretending to be somebody else on social networking sites such as Facebook.
